THE ANNUAL "TAKE MY HAND" CONCERT AT KOERNER HALL
ON JUNE 9, 2010**

A BENEFIT CONCERT FOR ALLI'S JOURNEY

Each year "Take my Hand" features a variety of Canadian musicians donating their time and talents to help support Alli's Journey. This year's line up will not disappoint, which includes: **Sophie Milman** a Russian born and Toronto-based singer. On her newest album "*Take Love Easy*" she transforms pop favourites into jazz arrangements. **Jully Black**, who will be singing a mix of urban, dance and rock songs from her latest album "Black Book"; the indie rock band **The Rural Alberta Advantage**, and **Evening Hymns** performing from Jonas Bonnetta's new album "Spirit Guides"

Also performing is **Aion Clarke**, a talented young vocalist whose mix of pop/soul classics is capturing the hearts of audiences at home and internationally; **Ohbijou**, a seven piece pop orchestral phenomenon performing from their newest album "Beacons", and **Dan Mangan**, a singer/songwriter performing hit songs from his latest release "Nice, Nice, Very Nice". **Florence K**, Cuban, Brazilian and Traditional Rhythm and Blues pianist from Quebec; and **KellyLee Evans**, soul pop singer-songwriter returns to "Take My Hand" to perform songs from her newly released "*The Good Girl*."

Since its inception in 2006, Alli's Journey, a non-profit organization, has raised funds to support initiatives for young adults ages 18-35 with cancer.

All proceeds from the night will go to fund Alli's Journey projects. This year proceeds will go towards building a sanctuary for young adults fighting cancer at the **Wellspring** located at Sunnybrook hospital. This will be the first room ever dedicated to this cause in Canada.

Alli's Journey is a non-profit charitable organization created by a young woman named Alli Shapiro Amar. She was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma cancer at the age of 19. While enduring treatment, Alli and her mother, Pam Shainhouse, noticed the lack of resources for young adults with cancer. This made them determined to raise money for the young adult cancer population (ages 18-35). While Alli is no longer with us, her memory lives on through the cause.
